Personal protective equipment (PPE) Putting safety first



Safety first – that is the overriding aim of personal protective equipment (PPE) and the legislation that regulates it. From sunglasses and sports goggles, through oven gloves and hi-vis clothing, to safety shoes and chainsaw trousers, PPE products are designed to protect users undertaking a range of activities, from the mundane to the extreme.

WHAT IS PPE?

PPE is any product designed to be worn or held by an individual for protection against one or more safety hazards. The range of PPE products is immense and includes products for:

- Recreational use
- Professional use

EUROPEAN REGULATIONS

Products are regulated in the EU under PPE Regulation 2016/425. This applies to most safety products intended for use in domestic, leisure and sports activities, as well as for professional use.

Following Brexit, the UK requires compliance with Regulation 2016/425 as brought into GB law and amended.

All PPE products covered under 2016/425 must meet the essential health and safety requirements (EHSR) listed and described in Annex II of the PPE Regulation.

Manufacturers seeking to place products onto European markets need to be aware of these legislative requirements and plan their product certification activities accordingly.



CERTIFICATION UNDER REGULATION 2016/425

PPE products are classified into three categories – I, II and III – each requiring the manufacturer to produce an EU Declaration of Conformity (DoC).

TECHNICAL DOCUMENTATION UNDER REGULATION 2016/425

Must include all data relevant to the means used by the manufacturer to demonstrate compliance with the EHSR relevant to the PPE product type.

EU/UKCA type examination requires a Notified/Approved Body to review the technical documentation against the essential health and safety requirements, which are normally achieved by ensuring compliance with the appropriate harmonized standard.

NOTIFIED BODY STATUS

Our facilities in Finland (Notified Body 0598) and the UK (Approved Body 0120) provide type-approval examination to PPE Regulation 2016/425.
