WITH MALAYSIAN SUSTAINABLE PALM OIL (MSPO)**

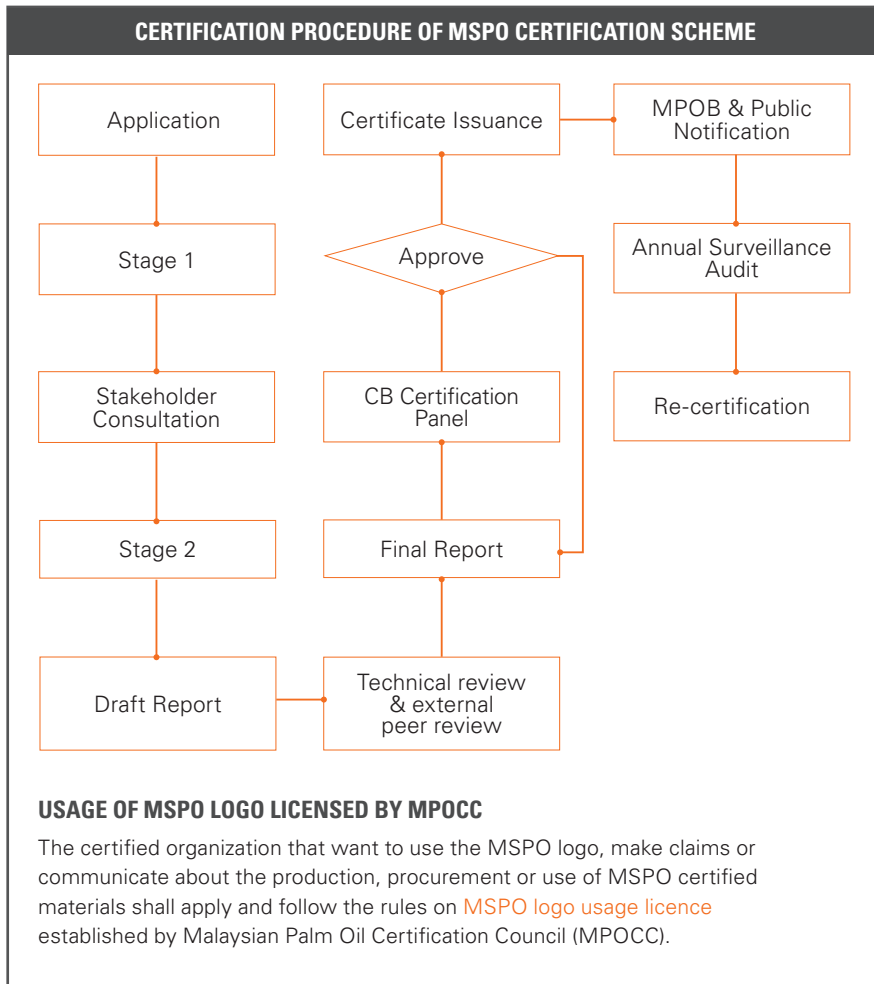
The Malaysian Standard on Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO) addresses sustainability issues and challenges in relation to the multi-stakeholders involved in the industry.

The Malaysian Standard provides general principles on the requirements for plantations and organized smallholders to establish, maintain and

improve their operational practices within a management system framework, which enables the adoption of a systematic and integrated approach towards attaining sustainable production of palm oil.

The MSPO covers the areas of operations of the oil palm industry along the whole supply chain comprising

independent and organized smallholders, plantations and palm oil mills. It also includes smallholder groupings such as the Sustainable Palm Oil Cluster (SPOC) and other group management systems. This certification procedure is to be adhered to in order to be sustainable certified.
