1. PRODUCTS CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT	
PROGRAM NAME	Pre-shipment Verification of Conformity to Standards.
PROGRAM MANDATED BY	Zanzibar Bureau of Standards (ZBS).
IMPLEMENTATION DATE	1 July 2023.
	 Ensure quality of products, health and safety, and environmental protection for Zanzibaris as reflected in the scope of the regulated products.
	 Minimize the risk of unsafe and sub-standard goods entering Zanzibar through the execution of conformity assessment activities in the country of export. This will help ensure that consumers are protected from unsafe and sub-standard goods, and that Zanzibari manufacturers are not subjected to unfair competition.
	 Prohibiting the entry of shoddy and counterfeit products.
PROGRAM OBJECTIVES	 Facilitate the clearance process by eliminating bottlenecks caused by the verification performed on arrival at entry points.
	 The guiding principle of the PVoC programme is based on Article 5 of Technical Barriers to Trade (TBT/WTO), which requires that technical requirements (i.e. Standards) applied to foreign products must also be applied to domestically manufactured products.
	 Establishing a quality import inspection regime that is in harmony with that of member states of the East African Community.
	Exporter submits to SGS the following documents:
	 Request for Certification (indicating the point of entry in Zanzibar).
VERIFICATION PROCESS	Proforma Invoice.
	 Quality Management System Certification/s. Conformity Documents (test reports, quality certificates, analysis reports, etc.).
	 Final invoice (except Airfreight & courier shipments).
ROUTES	Three methods are proposed to the exporters to demonstrate the compliance of their products and obtain a Certificate of Conformity (CoC):
	ROUTE A: Applicable to any goods and any trader.



	 ROUTE B: Recommended for frequent exporter with homogeneous products (Registration is renewable annually, subject to continual compliance). ROUTE C: For Manufacturers.
APPROVED LABORATORY	To obtain evidence that all requirements are met in the applicable standards or technical requirements, goods must undergo one or a combination of the following verification process: Inspection. Laboratory testing. Laboratories accredited to ISO/IEC 17025 A Recognized Laboratory practicing good laboratory practices and approved by PVoC Service Provider. Manufacturers' laboratory witnessed by PVoC Provider. Factory audit. Documentary verification. After verification process is completed and results are satisfactory, exporter will have to submit the Final Invoice (except for airfreight and courier shipments) for the issuance of the CoC.
DOCUMENTATION	A Certificate of Conformity (CoC) is the document issued to evidence the compliance of products to the relevant approved standards. • This document is required for Customs clearance.
CERTIFICATE	In instances where the Certificate of Conformity (CoC) is required, but not obtained, the following will apply: • For consignments shipped to Zanzibar without CoC, importers may be issued a penalty of 5% CIF as well as payment for Destination Inspection fees. • ZBS will only grant release of such goods upon completion of inspection, testing (where applicable) and verifying conformity to the Standard. It is the seller's responsibility to ensure that shipments to Zanzibar are affected only upon issuance of a Certificate of Conformity or confirmed certification decision.
OTHERS	If the reports from the verification activities such as testing or inspection show discrepancies versus the verification criteria, exporters will be informed accordingly and provided sufficient time to make the necessary corrections; if those are not or cannot be made a "NonConformity Report" (NCR) will be issued. This may imply that goods are not allowed to be shipped into Zanzibar. It is the seller's responsibility to ensure that shipments to Zanzibar are affected only upon issuance of a Certificate of Conformity or confirmed certification decision.

REGULATED PRODUCTS	As per Point 4. Regulated product lists are subject to change and it is recommended for Imports to Zanzibar that the ZBS website is monitored for any amendments thereto.

Coverage and conditions

The above fees cover the documentary verification, physical inspections of goods issuance of CoC/NCR. The above fees are net fees and <u>do not include</u> the following:

- Laboratory Testing: to be quoted on a case by case basis.
- Product Registration.
- Manufacturer Licensing.
- Sampling of bulk shipment.
- Re-inspection.
- · Witnessing of Loading and sealing of containers.

The SGS fee shall be calculated on the basis of the value of the invoice presented by the exporter or the importer. SGS will be entitled to its fees regardless of whether after its assessment of the goods the exporter or importer does not provide the information or documents necessary for the final issuance of the CoC, or for any reason does not proceed with the shipment of the goods.

- 3. Products included in the Import Prohibited list and exempted list are non-regulated.

This product list may be varied from time to time by mutual consent of both parties' subject to confirmation of such variation by the parties in writing. It is recommended for Imports to Zanzibar that Importers and Exporters consult the ZBS website for any updates to regulated, non-regulated and exempted goods, as this may be subject to change.
