ISO/IEC 27002:2022 was published in February 2022. This update means that ISO/IEC 27001:2022 is expected to be published later in the year. The below should help your journey.

- Familiarize yourself with ISO/IEC 27002:2022.
- Help your team understand the changes. We have training to support.
- Do a gap analysis of existing controls vs. ISO/IEC 27002:2022, using Annex B as guidance.

- 6 Implement relevant changes based on your risk treatment plan and new/modified controls.
- Look at the evidence for including or excluding necessary controls. Update your SoA accordingly.
- Ensure your risk assessment, security objectives and context are aligned.

- 7 Conduct an internal audit and MRM to see if changes have been implemented effectively.
- 8 ISO/IEC 27001:2022 is published.
- 9 Contact us to schedule your transition audit.
