# FITcert

FITcert is a certification system that helps fitness centers operate to optimum health, safety and hygiene standards. The certification scheme for fitness clubs is based on the new European quality standard EN 17229 - 'Fitness centres - Requirements for facilities and operation'. Fitness centres are assessed by an independent ISO 17020-certified institution. By obtaining the FITcert certificate, fitness clubs are able to demonstrate that their business operations comply with the EN 17229 quality guideline.

### **FITcert offers the following benefits:**

- A transparent system for customers demonstrating that the facility is professional and responsible with regard to health, safety and hygiene
- Various training and education opportunities for staff to maintain and improve standards
- The opportunity for fitness centres to single themselves out from other fitness clubs

### **The FITcert certification process consists of five stages:**

Stages 1 and 2: Preparation phase and Self-assessment (can be done simultaneously)

- The fitness centre receives full standards requirements, a step-by-step programme and a guide (1)

- Listing in the public register of participating European fitness centres and informing members about participation in FITcert (1)
- The fitness centre answers an EN 17229-based questionnaire about business operations and backs this up with relevant documentation (2)
- The fitness centre receives confirmation as EuropeActive Recognized Club, followed by Stage 3 (2)

#### Stage 3: Conformity assessment

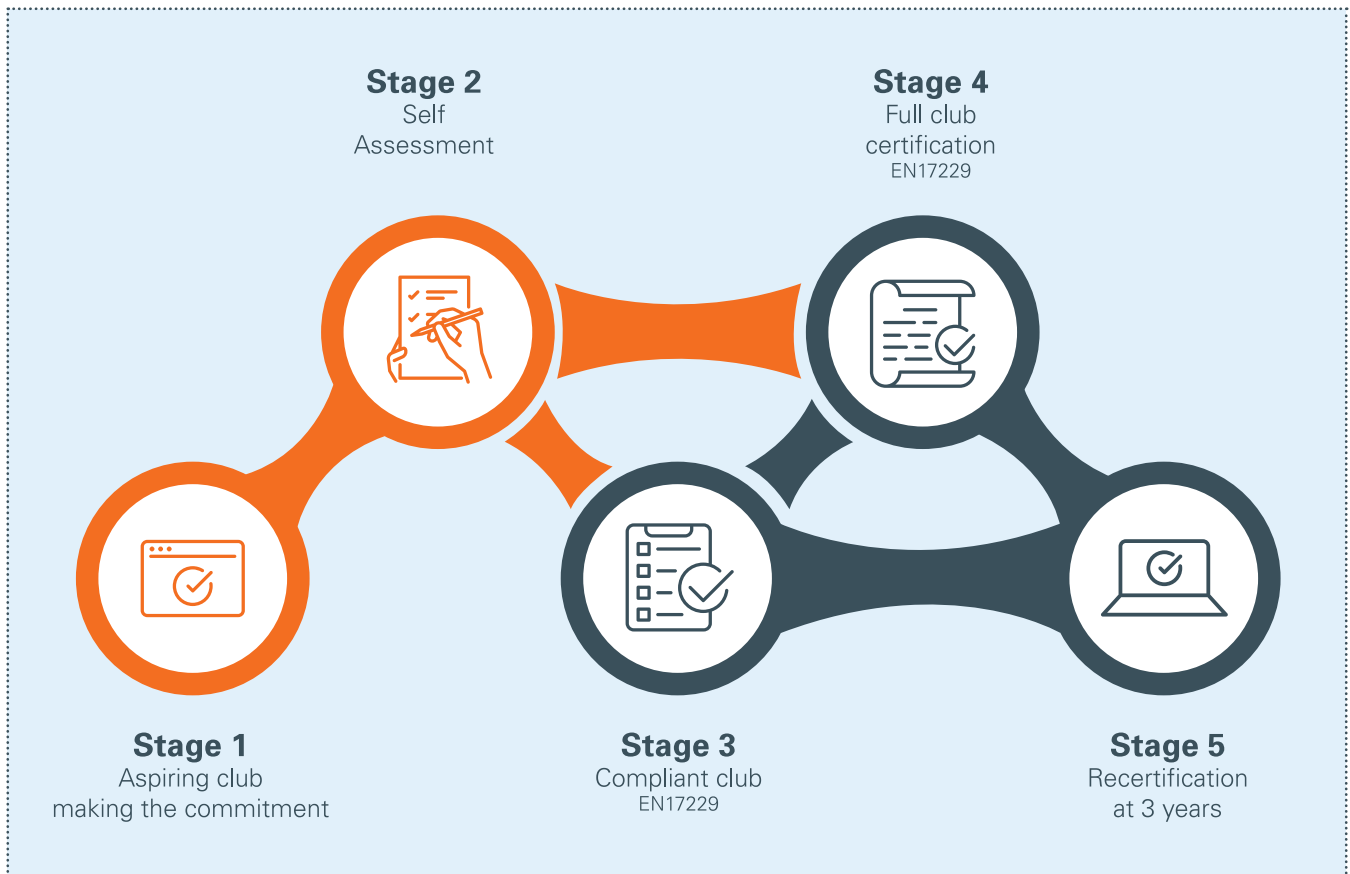
- An online conformity assessment, based on the core EN 17229 quality guidelines, is performed by an independent ISO 17020-certified body, such as SGS, within one year of completing Stage 2 or 3
- The fitness centre receives the EN 17229, issued by SGS and EuropeActive, after which the status is updated

#### Stage 4: Full club certification

- An independent assessment of the full EN 17229 quality guidelines with both on-site and online audits takes place within one year of completing Stage 2 or 3
- The fitness centre retains the EN 17229 certificate for three years (re-certification possible after two years)

#### Stage 5: Re-certification

- The fitness centre receives an annual update on standard changes and additions
- Re-certification for FITcert Stage 3 or Stage 4
