Notification on MSPO Assessment of **Morisem Palm Oil Mill Sdn. Bhd (Leepang Palm Oil Mill)**

Date: 13th-17th November 2017

Dear Stakeholders,

Morisem Palm Oil Mill Sdn. Bhd. has applied to SGS (Malaysia) Sdn. Bhd. and will conduct Initial Certification Assessment at **Leepang Palm Oil Mill** and its supply base, located in MDLD 5123, KM 3 Jalan Segama, 91100 Lahad Datu, Sabah, Malaysia against the requirement of the **Malaysia Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO), MS2530: General Principle** for the plantation operation and **MPOB/MSPO/TR/07: MSPO Palm Oil Supply Chain Traceability Requirements** for Palm Oil Mill.

MSPO is Malaysian Standard established in the involvement of oil palm industry, Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB) and Malaysian Palm Oil Council (MPOC) toward the production of sustainable palm oil products. MSPO has been launched on 19th November 2013 by Deputy Prime Minister. The standard is operated by Malaysian Palm Oil Certification Council (MPOCC); an independent organization and incorporated under the Malaysian Companies Act, 1965. The organization has been taking an active role in the MSPO certification processes and planned to fulfill all MSPO requirement throughout its production and processes. SGS Malaysia has arranged to conduct assessment on the organization which operating **01 mill** and **07 estates** on **13/11/2017 to 17/11/2017**.
