Notification on MSPO Assessment of Sarawak Oil Palms Bhd (Sabaju Palm Oil Mill)

Date: 18 - 22 December 2017

Dear Stakeholders,

Sarawak Oil Palms Bhd has applied to SGS (Malaysia) Sdn. Bhd. and will conduct Initial Certification Assessment at **Sabaju Palm Oil Mill** and its supply base, located in Lot 2, Block 14, Lavang Land District, 97000 Bintulu, Sarawak, Malaysia against the requirement of the **Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO), MS2530-3:2013 Part 3: General principles for oil palm plantations and organized smallholders** for the plantation operation and **MS2530-4:2013 Part 4: General principles for palm oil mills** for Palm Oil Mill.

MSPO is Malaysian Standard established in the involvement of oil palm industry, Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB) and Malaysian Palm Oil Council (MPOC) toward the production of sustainable palm oil products. MSPO has been launched on 19th November 2013 by Deputy Prime Minister. The standard is operated by Malaysian Palm Oil Certification Council (MPOCC); an independent organization and incorporated under the Malaysian Companies Act, 1965. The organization has been taking an active role in the MSPO certification processes and planned to fulfill all MSPO requirement throughout its production and processes. SGS Malaysia has arranged to conduct assessment on the organization which operating **01 mill** and **07 estates** on **18 to 22 December 2017**.
