## Notification on MSPO Assessment of Bintulu Lumber Development Sdn Bhd

Dear Stakeholders,

Bintulu Lumber Development Sdn Bhd has applied to SGS (Malaysia) Sdn. Bhd. and will conduct Initial Certification Assessment at BLD Igan Palm Oil Mill located in Lot 559, Block 0, Kabang Land, District Sibu, Sarawak against the requirement of the Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO), MS2530-4:2013 Part 4: General principles for palm oil mills for the Mill operation.

MSPO is Malaysian Standard established in the involvement of oil palm industry, Malaysian Palm Oil Board (MPOB) and Malaysian Palm Oil Council (MPOC) toward the production of sustainable palm oil products. MSPO has been launched on 19th November 2013 by Deputy Prime Minister. The standard is operated by Malaysian Palm Oil Certification Council (MPOCC); an independent organization and incorporated under the Malaysian Companies Act, 1965. The organization has been taking an active role in the MSPO certification processes and planned to fulfill all MSPO requirement throughout its production and processes. SGS Malaysia has arranged to conduct assessment on the organization which operating **01 mill** on **21 May 2018**.
